Did you know that the Board of Selectmen has officially designated April 2018 as **Greta Carey Month** in Williamsburg and Haydenville, in recognition of the many contributions artist Greta Carey (1910-2004) made to our community during her lifetime?

Greta taught oil painting and rug hooking at the Hill Institute for many years and served as president of the Williamsburg Brush & Palette Club. Her paintings of town buildings and scenes grace the walls of the town offices and libraries. The four large murals Greta painted for The Williams House in 1974 are hanging once again at The Brewmaster's Tavern, and the quilt she designed and finished for the 1971 town bicentennial is proudly displayed at Meekins Library.

In honor of Greta, her daughter, Willo, has donated over 70 of Greta's paintings to be sold for the benefit of three town institutions her mother valued deeply—the Williamsburg Libraries, the Williamsburg Historical Society, and the Williamsburg Grange.
